UNIFORM POLICY

All senior and junior players, coaches, parents and members are expected to comply to our club's uniform policy. This policy is designed to protect the JKCC and its partners and to protect the health and safety of all our players.

All players should be wearing the current playing shirts and not previous versions.

JKCC PLAYING UNIFORM

Playing Pants:

- Seniors
 - White cricket pants for two-day matches.
 - White cricket pants for two-day matches.
 - No Districts playing pants.
- Junior Boys
 - White cricket pants.
 - No cream-coloured pants.
 - No Districts playing pants.
- Junior Girls
 - JKCC green cricket pants purchased from JKCC Club Merchandise Shop.
 - No Districts playing pants.
- No other club logo (including Districts) on cricket pants.

Playing Shirts:

- Seniors
 - Long or short sleeve white shirt for two-day cricket and;
 - Long or short sleeve green shirt for one- day matches.
 - Current JKCC playing shirt only must be worn. Previous versions of JKCC cricket shirts are not to be worn.
 - No Districts shirts or other shirts with logos on to be worn.
- Junior Boys and Girls
 - JKCC long sleeve green shirt. Purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop.
 - JKCC short sleeve green shirts may be worn by Year 11 (U17) players only. Long sleeve is preferred.
 - To ensure consistency across the club no names or numbers should be printed on the back of playing shirts.
 - Current JKCC playing shirt only must be worn. Previous versions of JKCC cricket shirts are not to be worn.
 - No Districts shirts or other shirts with logos on to be worn.

Playing Hats:

- Seniors
 - JKCC cap or JKCC bucket hat which can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop or
 - Wide brim white cricket hat (with no logos on), which can be purchased from Meulemans Cricket Centre.
- Junior Boys
 - Stages 1 and 2 can wear JKCC bucket hat, which can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop or
 - Wide Brim white cricket hat. These can be purchased from Meulemans Cricket Centre.
 - Stage 3 can wear JKCC cap or JKCC bucket hat which can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop or
 - Wide Brim white cricket hat. These can be purchased from Meulemans Cricket Centre.
 - Commemorative Baggy Green Award caps are not to be worn in matches in any age groups.
- Junior Girls
 - All stages can wear either a JKCC cap or JKCC bucket hat which can be purchased from JKCC Club Merchandise Shop or;
 - Wide Brim white cricket hat. These can be purchased from Meulemans Cricket Centre.
 - Commemorative Baggy Green Award caps are not to be worn in matches in any age groups.

Shoes:

- Predominately white shoes or
- rubber moulded cricket shoes
- Spikes are not to be worn.

JKCC TRAINING UNIFORM

- JKCC training shirts, shorts, pants and caps can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop but are not compulsory.
- No other club logos ie Districts to be worn when training with JKCC teams.
- Otherwise, can wear comfy clothing.

COACHES

- JKCC club polo or JKCC long sleeved playing shirt and JKCC cap (the club will provide these for the coach's first season only).
- JKCC Club training shorts or pants can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop.
- Coaches must wear enclosed footwear when coaching and umpiring.

MANAGERS

- JKCC club polo (the club will provide these for the manager's first season only).

- JKCC Club training shorts or pants can be purchased from the JKCC Club Merchandise Shop.

UMPIRES

- When umpiring in juniors' games, a club polo and/or the umpires vest must be worn.
- Enclosed shoes must also be worn when out on the field umpiring

SUPPORTERS

- JKCC Supporters can purchase a range of items, which includes the club polo, Cub Crew shirt, jacket and hoodie and a supporters cap.
